


Flatpicking Bluegrass Lick

Bluegrass is a great style to play! The picking is fast and a solo is typically a flurry of notes cascading over each other.

Here's a simple flatpicking bluegrass lick in G using hammer-ons and pull-offs. The hammer-on and pull-off notes should be as close to volume to the picking notes as possible.
